RULES of the SCOUT BASE

- 1) The Scout Law is the Law of the base of the Scout Group AGESCI Roma 41 (hereafter "Base" and "Scout Group").
- 2) The Base is the home of the coccinelle and lupetti (8-11 years old), guide and esploratori (12-16 years old), scolte and rover (16-21 years old), and leaders of the Scout Group AGESCI Roma 41, granted by the Parish of San Gregorio Barbarigo alle Tre Fontane (hereafter "Parish") to carry out informal educational activities according to the scout method for enrolled children and young adults; it is also the legal base of the association in which the group identifies.
- 3) The "Comunità Capi" (group of all the leaders of the Scout Group), every year chooses a team (hereafter "Hospitality Team" or "Team") to organize the logistics of hospitality within the Base.
- 4) The Base hosts scout groups and organized parish groups (hereafter "guest groups") at the times, places, and modalities established by the Hospitality Team, ensuring that the guests' reception does not interfere with the educational activities for which the Base has statutory priority. The Team reserves the right to cancel a reservation at any time due to educational and logistical needs, without any liability for the Scout Group.
- 5) The Base, in a scout style and Christian spirit of hospitality, offers what is available with no pretense of presenting itself as an accommodation facility: it is not a B&B, hotel, or hostel; there are no beds, no industrial kitchen, no private bathrooms, or cleaning services: the Base is managed on a voluntary basis by the young adults and leaders of the Scout Group without any profit and according to their availability, talents, and limitations.

- 6) The Hospitality Team assigns the areas of the Base based on the needs of each guest group; it can provide, in consultation with the Parish, parish spaces not included in the Scout Base complex.
- 7) The Hospitality Team does its best to ensure that guest groups find clean and tidy rooms in which to spend their stay.
- 8) Guest groups are required to:
 - a) ensure the **cleanliness of the assigned spaces and common areas** including toilets, throughout their stay using the products provided by the Team;
 - b) **use the kitchen respectfully**, use the available cookware with respect for common property, washing it thoroughly after use;
 - c) compensate the Group for any **consumed food items present in the Base's kitchen** by their value to allow for their repurchase, or autonomously repurchase them;
 - d) respect the **quiet hours from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM and from 11:00 PM to 8:00** AM in compliance with municipal laws;
 - e) "love and respect nature" by paying attention to water consumption and recycling waste into the appropriate bins and depositing full bags in the bins located outside the Base;
 - f) wear appropriate clothing inside the Base and especially in the outdoor parish spaces: it is forbidden to wear only swimsuits without shirts and shorts. We ask guest scout groups to attend church celebrations in full uniform, and non-scout groups to wear attire appropriate for a sacred place;
 - g) **light fires only in spaces authorized by the Team**, manage them sensibly and competently, and extinguish them with water after each activity;
 - h) not open storage benches, cabinets, or drawers in the Base unless specifically authorized by the Team;





- i) ensure **not to lose the set of keys to the Base**, if given upon arrival: the cost of replacing locks and reproducing keys will be on the group responsible for the loss;
- j) carefully **lock all doors every evening and whenever leaving the Base for your and other people's safety**; the light in front of the entrance door stays on all night.
- 9) The Hospitality Team reserves the right to terminate the stay of guest groups at any time for any violation of these Rules.
- 10) The Scout Group is not responsible for thefts or losses during the stay at the Base.
- 11) Participation in Holy Masses at the Parish is possible:
 - a) from late June to mid-September: Monday to Friday at 8:30 AM; Saturday and preholidays at 8:30 AM and 6:30 PM; Sunday and holidays at 9:30 AM - 11:00 AM -7:00 PM;
 - b) from mid-September to late June: Monday to Saturday at 8:30 AM and 6:30 PM, and Sunday and holidays at 9:30 AM - 11:00 AM - 12:30 PM - 7:00 PM;
 - c) on request, subject to the availability of the priests (through the Team).
- 12) Contacts information and addresses of stores, supermarkets, and pharmacies for guest groups are available on the board at the entrance of the Base.
- 13) Access to the Base is subject to the acceptance and compliance with these Rules, and entering the premises implies full acceptance.

These rules consist of 13 articles and were approved by the "Comunità Capi" of the Scout Group AGESCI Roma 41 on December 4, 2023.
